Through these two petitions under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.249 dated 20.12.2016 under Sections 323, 324, 326 and 341 I.P.C. and D.D.R. No.27 dated 31.12.2016 under Sections 323, 324, 325, 341/34 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Sadar, Jalandhar, on the basis of compromise.

On presentation of the petition, parties were directed to appear before the Area Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the Area Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar and got recorded their statements for compromise. Report bearing No.1975G dated 13.07.2017 from the concerned Magistrate duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar vide letter No.1677G/ JRK dated 14.07.2017 has also been received.

According to the report of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar, the compromise between the parties is genuine, without any undue influence or coercion from any side.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.249 and DDR No.27, are hereby quashed.

Petitions are disposed of accordingly.
