RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.83 dated 04.05.2017 under Sections 452, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC and Sections (325 and 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar, on the basis of compromise dated 22.05.2017 (Annexure P-3).

Pursuant to the order dated 28.09.2017 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 24.10.2017 to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.118 dated 24.10.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar vide Endst. No. 9749R dated 26.10.2017..

According to the report, the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class

is satisfied that compromise entered into between the parties is genuine,

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voluntary, and without any inducement, threat or pressure. None of the accused has been declared proclaimed offender in this case.

Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class dated 24.10.2017 and the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, FIR No.83 dated 04.05.2017 under Sections 452, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC and Section 326, 325 IPC registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
