Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 is for quashing of FIR No. 3 dated 30.4.2015 (Annexure P-1), registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station NRI District Gurdaspur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

This Court vide order dated 20.7.2017, had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise. The case was adjourned to 20.9.2017.

On 20.9.2017, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners. Even today no representation has been made on their behalf.

Report has been received from Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurdaspur dated 31.8.2017, in which it is stated that complainant did not come present in Court so as to record his statement in support of the compromise.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No. 3, who is the complainant, states that the matter has not been compromised between the parties and the complainant has not appeared before the trial Court.

In view of the fact that present petition has been filed seeking quashing on the basis of compromise and complainant has not come forward to accept this compromise, present petition is dismissed. However, it shall not be a bar for the petitioner to file a petition seeking quashing of the FIR on the basis of merits.
