Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C has been made for quashing FIR No.51 dated 03.05.2017 for offence punishable under Sections 68(D) and 67(A) of Information Technology Act, 2000(herein after referred to as the 'Act'), registered at Police Station Sadar Kotkapura, District Faridkot, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 11.05.2017 (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to the order dated 31.05.2017 of this Court, the parties appeared before the learned Area Magistrate to get recorded their statements. Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot has also sent its report vide covering letter having Endorsement No.659 dated 11.07.2017, which has been duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Faridkot, vide Endorsement No.2273(EB.) dated 14.07.2017.

According to the report, the Chief Judicial Magistrate is satisfied that the parties have made an amicable settlement and recorded their statements voluntarily in the Court without any coercion or undue influence.

Considering the report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate dated 11.07.2017 and the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, FIR No.51 dated 03.05.2017 for offence punishable under Sections 68(D) and 67(A) of the Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Kotkapura, District Faridkot, and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
