2. On the asking of the Court, Mr. D.R. Singla, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3-State.

3. The petitioners contend that they had been motivatedly framed in a false criminal case registered in Police Station Sonipat Sadar, District Sonipat at the behest of some interested liquor vend owners. Their further grievance is that their own version regarding the occurrence which has been referred to earlier in the representation (Annexure P-2) and subsequently in greater detail in Annexure P-3 is not at all being considered by the Police Authorities in a fair and objective manner.

4. After hearing Ld. counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction upon the respondent No.2 to take cognizance of the allegations contained in the petition as well as the

representation (Annexure P-3) and, thereafter, to take appropriate steps by way of effective and close monitoring of the investigation concerning the occurrence related to FIR No.144 dated 24.04.2017.
