CRM-M No.1973 of 2017

The present petition directs challenge against order dated 03.11.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Gurgaon whereby interim maintenance awarded to the respondent-wife has been reduced to Rs.22,000/- per month by taking into consideration expenses being incurred on the minor child by the petitioner who is at present in custody of the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that maintenance at the rate of Rs.22,000/- per month allowed in favour of the wife is also on higher side and liable to be reduced. Another submission made by counsel is that the petitioner-wife is working in Royal Public School, Wazirpur,

Sector 95-A, Gurgaon as is evident from the photographs (Annexure P-2 colly.).

I have gone through the order passed by the Court in revision but do not find any reason much less illegality warranting intervention. So far as the plea of the petitioner with regard to the respondent-wife having joined some service in a school, the petitioner is left at liberty to file an appropriate application before the Court below with regard to subsequent events and the same shall be decided by the Court in accordance with law.

Disposed of accordingly.
