The petitioner is stated to have jumped bail on one occasion, leading to the cancellation of his bail bonds. He is stated to be facing trial for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under Sections 279 and 304-A IPC.

A perusal of the order of the learned Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur, dated 11.5.2017, shows that the petitioner remained absent from Court on 11.1.2017 and that the next date of hearing fixed before the trial court was 20.5.2017. Obviously, the petitioner has not appeared even on 20.5.2017.

Consequently, I see no ground to admit the petitioner to anticipatory bail. This petition is dismissed. However, upon the petitioner surrendering before the trial court and filing an application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. that would be dealt with and expeditiously, on its own merits.
