Prayer made in this petition is for issuance of necessary directions to respondent No.2 in the context of protection of life and personal liberty of the petitioner from being invaded at the hands of private respondents.

The petitioner alleges harassment at the hands of respondent Nos.5 and 6 in the context of matrimonial advertisement and the further *mala fides* of the aforesaid respondents in extracting the amount of Rs.4 lacs from the petitioner. A complaint was made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga. With the help of SP(H) Moga, a compromise was struck, but the same was not adhered to by the private respondents, resulting in filing a representation by the petitioner before respondent No.2 on 28.04.2017.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Shilesh Gupta, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4. Let requisite copies of the petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon reply at this stage.

At this stage, without meaning anything on the pleadings contained in the present petition, respondent No.2 is directed to take into consideration the pending representation moved by the petitioner on 28.04.2017 and take appropriate action in accordance with law, without being swayed away by any consideration in terms of pleadings or anything recorded in the preceding part of the order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
