Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to register a case against respondents No.4 to 6 for the relevant offence in view of title of the petitioner in respect of land measuring 18 Kanals 8 Marlas on the basis of Will.

Respondents No.4 to 6 are claimed to be owners of adjoining land and in order to inject them, a civil suit was filed by the petitioner in which order of status quo was granted on 15.02.2017. Despite the stay, private respondents destroyed the crop of the petitioner for which a representation was made to respondent No.3 on 15.05.2017 which was marked as dasti-241/15.05.2017 and thereafter, representation dated 16.05.2017

was moved before respondent No.2 which was marked as 2055/SP dated 16.05.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that despite the aforesaid representations having been filed, no action has been taken.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rimplejeet Kaur, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

At this stage, in view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of filing any reply to the petition as no order prejudicial to interest of any of the party is being passed.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the pending representations of the petitioner in accordance with law.
