Petitioner alleged harassment at the hands of respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is unmarried. One Nazma @ Rani is a divorcee having two sons from her previous marriage. She is running a beauty parlour. Petitioner and said Nazma @ Rani developed some friendship/relationship, but thereafter Nazma @ Rani in connivance with HC Inayat Khan started harassing and blackmailing the petitioner. A settlement was arrived at wherein an amount of Rs.50,000/- was paid by the petitioner to Nazma @ Rani and HC Inayat Khan.

In the context of continued harassment, petitioner has not approached any Police Authority in compliance of Section 154 Cr.P.C.

At this stage, learned counsel wishes to withdraw the present petition with a liberty to approach the Incharge, Police Station, City-2, Sangrur at the first instance.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

In the event of filing such application/complaint before the Incharge, Police Station City-2 Sangrur, the same shall be decided in accordance with law.

Petition stands disposed of.
