The instant writ petition has been filed seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus, commanding the respondents to re-fix the seniority of the petitioners.

The matter was taken up in the year 2003. Being an old case, it was listed for hearing in the motion list on 27.01.2017. The matter was taken up for hearing and there was no one to represent the petitioners. This court, while noting that counsel, who had filed the petition namely Mr. Y.S. Bajwa, Advocate, was no longer in active practice, directed that notices should be issued to the petitioners. As per office noting dated 27.03.2017, notices issued to the petitioners have been received back unserved due to

incorrect addresses.

In view of the fact that there is no one to represent the petitioners nor is their correct addresses available with this court, this writ petition is being dismissed for want of prosecution. In case, the petitioners are having any grievance, they are at liberty to get the petition revived.
