Matter called twice. None appears for the respondents. Having regard to the prayer made in the present petition and the fact that there is no interim order, hence, petition do not survive for consideration.

In the present petition, petitioner has sought for writ of Prohibition to the respondents not to include supplementary charge sheet dated 8.2.1999 with reference to earlier charge-sheet dated 6.8.1997 and further sought for direction to the respondents to pass any order on the inquiring officer report. Since there is no interim order, consequently, inquiry must have been completed. Petitioner is not in a position to furnish later development after filing of this petition. If the respondents have concluded the departmental inquiry, necessary order shall be communicated to the petitioner. After conclusion of the inquiry, if any service benefit is due to the petitioner and if the petitioner submits a representation for extending service benefits to the respondents, the same shall be considered and extended in accordance with law.

With the above observation, petition stands disposed of.
