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**JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)**

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.26 dated 29.01.2015, under Section 304-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Jandiala Guru, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the trial. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from her.

Learned AAG Punjab for the respondent-State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that petitioner has joined the trial, as such, she is not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for

custodial interrogation and has joined the trial, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 31.05.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
