Reply on behalf of respondent No. 1 has been filed
today in the Court and the same is taken on record.

As per the reply, Assistant Commissioner of Police,
Central, Amritsar City carried out a detailed inquiry and noticed that
accused Neha had been residing separately from her husband for the
last about five years. Neha and Rinku had solemnized Court marriage
on 25.09.2016. Father of Rinku had disowned him. Deceased Rita Rani
had illicit relations with one Vishal alias Lalo. Thus, the relations
between Rita and Ashok Kumar were not cordial. On the date of
occurrence, there was exchange of hot words between deceased Rita
Rani and Vishal alias Lalo which provoked deceased who set her ablaze

at her parental house.

The learned State counsel states that no incriminating evidence could be collected against the petitioners, therefore, it was found that no case against the petitioner is made out.

On the statement made by the learned State counsel, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
