This order will dispose of CRM- M-. 20708 of 2016 and 18705 of 2016 as these have emerged out of the same FIR.

Counsel for the petitioners and respondent No. 2 have placed on record compromise deed, stated to signed by the complainant and Ravinder Singh and Karamjit Singh, husband and father-in-law respectively of the complainant. The same is taken on record.

Counsel for respondent No. 2 has got no objection if in view of

compromise between the parties, the petitioners' interim bail is made absolute.

In view of the above, interim bail granted to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) Parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of the compromise.
- (ii) The petitioners shall not offer any threat, promise or inducement to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing the same to the Investigating Officer/Court; and
- (iii) The petitioners shall not leave the limits of this country without prior permission of the Court.

Petitions stand disposed of.
