Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in a case bearing FIR No.268 dated 12.11.2016 registered under Sections 22 of the NDPS Act at Police Station City Faridkot.

As per prosecution, 700 intoxicated tablets were recovered from the co-accused and the petitioner ran away from the spot. Parameters in terms of anticipatory bail cannot be applied in such a case, where custodial interrogation of the person is required in order to extract information in respect of complicity of number of persons involved in the trade.

In view of above, no ground is made out for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition stands dismissed.
