Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Sandeep Sharma in case registered by way of FIR No.219 dated 28.04.2017 at Police Station Sadar Thanesar under Section 420 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 30.05.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ram Chander from Police Station Thanesar who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

However, learned counsel for the complainant Mr. Rakesh Nagpal, Advocate has sought to oppose the same on the grounds that the petitioner has filed fictitious receipt with this petition.

Keeping in view the stand of the State and that the complainant's grouse to that effect is well within his rights to move the Court under the relevant provisions of law, interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 30.05.2017 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
