Six persons were arrested with narcotic powder from a car. Petitioner was the driver of the car. Gurwinder Singh, Karamveer Singh, Manpreet Singh, Deepu Sharma and Sandeep Kumar were the other co-occupants of the car.

Co-accused namely Gurwinder Singh filed petition bearing CRM-M No.17206 of 2017, which was dismissed by this Court on 15.05.2017. The case of the petitioner cannot be segregated in terms of his complicity with that of co-accused Gurwinder Singh.

The only submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner is undergoing treatment in Drug

De-Addiction Centre, which in my view, is not a ground to grant concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, particularly when co-accused Gurwinder Singh could not get the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Petition is accordingly dismissed.
