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**INDERJIT SINGH, J.**

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty and to provide adequate security to protect them from respondents No.4 to 6, who are mother, brother and another relative of petitioner No.1. The petitioners, who are present in Court today, further contend that they being major have solemnized marriage with their own consent in accordance with law. The private respondents are not accepting the marriage of the petitioners and are extending threats to them.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have already moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, a copy of which is placed on record as Annexure P/4. He accordingly prays that appropriate direction may please be issued to the respondent No.2/Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to decide the said representation and he does not press the other relief asked in this petition.

In view of above, Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda/respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation dated 26.05.2017 (Annexure P-4) given by the petitioner. If respondent No.2 is satisfied that the petitioners are feeling serious threat to their life and liberty, then necessary steps to protect their life and liberty be taken immediately, as per law.

Disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
