This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 184 dated 06.11.2016, registered under Sections 498-A and 304-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Ateli, District Mahendergarh.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. It was a case of love marriage and there was no demand of dowry. It is further argued that in the investigation done by the police, there was no suicide note found on the spot while further arguing that the deceased was under severe depression on account of the fact that she was unable to conceive and did not get a job. It is also submitted that the petitioner in fact was supporting the deceased while she was undergoing her studies at Jaipur.

Upon notice, reply has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State. A reading of the reply would show that the police has verified from the Bank Manager of the Punjab National Bank that the petitioner would

transfer money into the account of the deceased. Counsel for the respondent-State further submits that the complainant has since been examined and out of total 14 witnesses, only one witness has been examined so far.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that statement of the complainant has been recorded; the petitioner is in custody since 07.11.2016 and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
