Learned counsel for the State has already filed reply by way of an affidavit on behalf of the respondent-State. Learned counsel for the State submits that the challan has already been filed after completion of investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that only 2 accused have been named in the challan and rest of them declared innocent. According to him, there is no fair investigation made by the police department. In my opinion, the petitioner has effective remedy of appearing before the Magistrate where the challan has been filed and asked for further investigation. The right of the complainant also to ask for further investigation is well guarded. In that view of the matter, petition is disposed of reserving liberty in favour of the petitioner as well the complainant to approach the trial Court for proper relief where the challan has been filed.
