AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that three persons were found with forged currency notes of ₹2,000/- each, namely, Manoj, Dharampal Kumar and Ache Lal. Out of these three persons, except for the petitioner, the other two persons have been granted regular bail, Annexures P-4 and P-3 respectively. Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is similarly placed as Dharampal Kumar and Ache Lal. He, therefore, prays that the petitioner may be granted concession of bail as the trial is under progress and the prosecution witnesses are being examined.

Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner has used forged notes/fake currency notes of ₹2,000/- and, therefore, he should not be granted the benefit of bail.

petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the co-accused, namely, Dharampal Kumar and Ache Lal have already been granted the concession of bail, the petitioner is also ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate/trial Court, Panipat.
