This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.153 dated 14.05.2016, under Sections 498-A IPC (Section 406 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station, City, Sangrur.

Anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioners vide order dated 10.06.2016 and thereafter, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. With the assistance of Mr. Maharaj Kumar, Advocate/Mediator, a compromise has been effected between the parties. In this regard, settlement agreement has been reduced into writing today i.e. 27.04.2017. As per compromise, Davinder Singh-husband will pay a sum of Rs.5,50,000/- to Karamjit Kaur-complainant as permanent

alimony for past, present and future maintenance. It has been further agreed that the gold articles lying in the police station, shall be returned to Devinder Singh.

In view of the said fact, the interim order dated 10.06.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute subject to the conditions mentioned in settlement agreement dated 27.04.2017.

Disposed of accordingly.
