This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of FIR No.116 dated 30.06.2015, registered under Sections 354, 295-A and 506 read with Section 34 IPC, at Police Station Division No.5, Jullunder, District Jalandhar City.

As per the office report, notice could not be issued to respondent No.2 as learned counsel for the petitioners did not file correct address. On the last date of hearing, learned counsel did not cause representation. Today as well, he is stated to be in some personal difficulty. It appears that learned counsel has lost interest in the matter.
