Petitioner is seeking direction to respondent-husband to comply with the order dated 31.07.2013 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib, whereby he has been directed to pay Rs.9500/- to the petitioner-wife.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in order to execute the aforesaid order, the petitioner has approached the Magistrate three times, but to no avail. As per Section 20 (4) of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, the Magistrate has to send copy of the order to the in-charge of the police station for providing monetary relief to the wife and the in-charge of the police station is to get the order complied with, so that the petitioner-wife is not compelled to file execution applications repeatedly before the Executing Court.

In these circumstance, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to the trial Court (Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri

Muktsar Sahib) to comply with the aforesaid provisions within a period of one month.

A copy of this order be sent to the trial Court (Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib) for strict compliance.
