Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.69 dated 01.04.2017 under Sections 452, 325, 323, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dakha, Maludh Police District Khanna.

This Court vide order dated 01.06.2017, while issuing notice of motion, has granted interim bail to the petitioners subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/ Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to order dated 01.06.2017, petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instruction from ASI Pardeep Kumar, submits that in terms of aforesaid order, petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 01.06.2017 are made absolute.

However, petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
