The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No. 543, dated 25.12.2014, under Sections 420, 447, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Saran, Faridabad, on the basis of compromise dated 17.12.2015 (Annexure P-2), which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is outcome of a monetary dispute for sale of land, which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 24.08.2016 had directed the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridabad, dated 14.10.2016, has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded, which indicates that they

have entered into compromise voluntarily and without any pressure or undue influence.

The afore-noted FIR is the outcome of a money dispute, which has now been resolved and the parties want to put quietus to the litigation.

In view the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466*, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 543, dated 25.12.2014, under Sections 420, 447, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Saran, Faridabad and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
