Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.59 dated 14.04.2017 under Sections 18, 21 and 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, the NDPS Act) registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated June 01, 2017 of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satinder Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Having considered the fact that the petitioner has joined the

investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated June 01, 2017 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
