The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.62, dated 02.08.2012, registered under Sections 307/325/324/323/148/149 IPC and 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, at Police Station Khalchian, District Amritsar.

On 1.6.2017, this Court passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, who is a 67 year old person, has only been roped in, and was, in fact, found innocent by the investigating agency. He has now been summoned by the trial Court on an application moved under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

Notice of motion, returnable on 6.7.2017.

In the meanwhile, without making any comment on the actual innocence or otherwise of the petitioner in the occurrence, upon his surrendering before the trial Court, keeping in view his age, he would be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of

that Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the previous order dated 1.6.2017, the petitioner has put in appearance before the trial Court.

Consequently, the interim order dated 1.6.2017 is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
