It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was arrested on 10.03.2017. The challan has been presented and the case is now fixed for framing of charges on 05.07.2017. His contention is that the name of the petitioner does not figure in the FIR. However, in the suicide note, his name figures but there is no allegation or overt act attributed to the petitioner as per the suicide note. His contention is that the co-accused Satish @ Billu, against whom it has been mentioned that a fraud has been committed by him upon the deceased Saroj, has been

titled as Satish @ Billu vs. State of Haryana.

Counsel for the State as well as the complainant have vehemently opposed the prayer made by the counsel for the petitioner.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case especially in the light of the regular bail having been granted to the co-accused Satish @ Billu on 02.06.2017, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate/trial Court, Hisar.
