FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The allegations against the petitioner in this regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. are that on 01.09.2016 some unknown persons have broke open the lock of the shop of complainant and have stolen two CCTV cameras, one mobile phone and Rs.4000/- in cash leading to the arrest of the petitioner on 05.09.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is behind the bars since more than one year and the recovery has already been made.

Learned State counsel has stoutly opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner on the ground of seriousness of the offence.

Appreciating the submissions and keeping in view the period of incarceration and that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near

future and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without advertng anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
