Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been made for quashing of F.I.R. No.32 dated 04.02.2017 under Sections 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code pertaining to Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar, on the basis of compromise (Annexure-P2 to P4).

On presentation of the petition, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

In compliance of the order dated 01.06.2017 of this Court, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nakodar on

07.06.2017 and got recorded their statements for compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide his covering letter No.4585 dated 14.06.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar vide Endst. No.1487G/JRK dated 16.06.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nakodar, the parties have compromised the matter voluntarily and no accused in the instant case has been declared as proclaimed offender.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.32, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
