Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.12 dated 18.02.2016 registered under Sections 498-A, 506 IPC at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran.

It is submitted that during the pendency of this petition, petitioner and respondent No.2 resumed cohabitation. They are residing together since 3rd August, 2017. Petitioner undertakes to take proper care of respondent No.2 and provide for all her basic needs and requirements. Therefore, this petition be allowed.

Respondent No.2 duly identified by her counsel is present in Court. She affirms and verifies that she is living together with the petitioner in her matrimonial home in a peaceful manner. She is being taken care of and has no objection in case, this petition is allowed subject to the petitioner honouring his word.

Learned counsel for the State verifies that the petitioner has joined investigation. It is also verified that the petitioner and respondent No.2 are living together.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances noted above, specifically the factum of the petitioner and respondent No.2, now cohabiting together, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Consequently, order dated 28th June, 2016 is made absolute.

Liberty is however, afforded to respondent No.2 to move an appropriate application in this matter in case the petitioner is not honouring his commitment.
