AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that after the registration of FIR, a compromise dated 07.09.2015 has been entered into between the parties, copy whereof has been appended as Annexure P-2. He contends that the co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Paramjit @ Pami and Munush Kumar, have been granted bail by this Court. The petition filed by the co-accused Paramjit @ Pami is CRM-M-33684-2015, which was allowed on 30.11.2015.

In the light of the above submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner, which is not disputed by the counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Surinder Singh, P.S. Tripari Patiala, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patiala.
