1. Petitioner(s) shall be represented through counsel;
2. shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;
3. shall not dispute his identity as accused;
4. shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in his absence but in the presence of the counsel;
5. shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the

- trial Court;
6. any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.
