Mr. Vikram Chaudhri, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners, submits that the matter has been compromised between the petitioners and the complainant (PUNSUP) and the amounts due and payable have been made good. This ends the dispute. A photocopy of the no due certificate issued by PUNSUP in this regard is taken on record as Mark – 'A'.

On the other hand, learned counsel representing respondents No.2 & 3 has no objection if the FIR and all other consequential proceedings be quashed on the basis of compromise.

In view of the above, FIR No.18 dated 25.02.2003 registered under Sections 406, 408, 420, 34, 120-B IPC at Police Station Vigilance

Bureau, Ferozepur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are ordered to be quashed.

Petition stands disposed of.
