LISA GILL, J.

The petitioner prays for bail pending trial in FIR No. 53 dated 15.02.2015 registered under Sections 323, 34, 307, 306, 302 IPC at Police Station Kaithal City, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Mahabir Singh, submits that the prosecution evidence, in this case, is almost complete. Ten (10) out of fifteen (15) prosecution witnesses have been examined, two (02) of them have been given up. Remaining three (03), it is submitted, shall be examined on 14.08.2017 i.e. the next date fixed before the learned trial Court.

Keeping in view the said position, no ground is made out for releasing the petitioner on bail pending trial at this stage.

Accordingly, this petition is dismissed.

Learned trial Court shall ensure that the said official witnesses
are examined on 14.08.2017.
