Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 10.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that though the petitioner No.2 Gurdeep Singh has an intention to comply the order dated June 01, 2017 passed by this Court, but there is a technical problem to comply the same, as the land owned by petitioner No.2 is in joint Khata for which partition proceedings have been initiated.

He further states that in order to secure the future of petitioner No.1 Gagandeep Kaur alias Nanako Bai, the petitioner No.2 is ready to deposit an amount of Rs.2,50,000/- in favour of petitioner No.1 within one month.

In view of the above, the order dated June 01, 2017 of this Court is modified to the extent that instead of transferring the land in the name of petitioner No.1, the petitioner No.2 shall deposit an amount of Rs.2,50,000/- in favour of petitioner No.1 in the shape of FDR for a period of three years in some nationalized bank fetching maximum rate of interest.

The petitioner No.2 shall produce the copy of the FDR within one month in the Registry.

The petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

It is made clear that in case this order is not complied with by the petitioner No.2 within the stipulated period of one month, the Registry shall put up the file.
