By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought pre-arrest bail in case FIR No. 0118, dated 26.05.2016, under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to trial Court to decide the bail application moved by the petitioner in case of his surrender/appearance.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to petitioner to surrender in the Court Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patiala within a period of 7 days and move an application seeking bail. In case, petitioner moves any application after his surrender, the same shall be dealt with and disposed of by the concerned Court within a period of 10 working days from the date of its filing.
