The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.156 dated 26.12.2015, for the offence under Sections 354/323/452/34 IPC registered at Police Station Sarhali, Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of panchayati compromise dated 05.10.2016 (Annexure P-2) and affidavit of the complainant and her sister dated 06.10.2016 (Annexure P-3 and P-4).

Reply by way of affidavit of Sukhjeet Kaur has been filed today in Court. The same is taken on record.

It was alleged by the complainant that petitioners have entered her house and using bad words for some money transaction and caught her and her sister with a bad intention and started doing illicit acts with them. On raising hue and cry, their parents and brother came there to rescue them but petitioners started beating their parents and brothers and also pushed and jolted them. On raising voice by the complainant, people gathered at the spot and then petitioner went to their house. On this background, the FIR was registered.

During the pendency of the trial, the matter has been resolved

between the petitioners and respondent No.2-Sukhjeet Kaur, vide

compromise deed dated 05.10.2016 (Annexure P-2).

In compliance with the order dated 23.01.2017 passed by this Court, the parties got recorded their statements before the trial Court. Report from the JMIC, Tarn Taran, has been received in this regard. As per report, Sukhjeet Kaur-complainant and accused-petitioners appeared before the trial Court on 16.03.2017 for getting their statements recorded in support of the compromise. In this regard statements of complainant- Sukhjeet Kaur and accused-petitioners were recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter and Sukhjeet Kaur-complainant has no objection if the present FIR is quashed against these accused. Statements of accused-petitioners were also recorded to the same effect. In view of separate statements of the parties, the Court is satisfied that the compromise is valid and genuine one.

Consequently, in view of the status report and the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 429**, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, this Court is of the view that no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No.156 dated 26.12.2015, for the offence under Sections 354/323/452/34 IPC registered at Police Station Sarhali, Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
