It appears that the petitioner has moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala in the context of protecting his life and liberty from being invaded by the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a cognizable offence was committed by the private respondents for which necessary reference can be made to the incharge of concerned police station, but the representation filed before respondent No.3 is confined to prayer of the petitioner in respect of violation his civil rights.

Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is still within his right to report the matter to the concerned incharge of the police station for taking action against the private respondents in accordance with law. In terms of his prayer for protecting his life and personal liberty from being

infringed by the private respondents, necessary directions be issued to respondent No.3.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ripudaman, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5-State. Let 5 copies of the petition be supplied to learned State Counsel during course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of calling upon reply.

At this stage, petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to look into the grievance of the petitioner in view of his representation filed on 05.04.2017 and pass appropriate order in accordance with law.

Disposed of accordingly.
