LISA GILL, J.

The petitioner, who is the mother-in-law of the complainant, prays for concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 128 dated 23.03.2017 registered under Section 498A, 377, 323, 506, 406, 354A, 376, 34 IPC at Police Station Kharkhoda, District Sonapat.

It is submitted that general and vague allegations have been levelled against the petitioner. The co-accused Rajesh i.e. the complainant's husband has been afforded the concession of bail pending trial. Learned counsel for the petitioner informs that in the interregnum the matter has been amicably resolved. The complainant is now residing with her husband. It is, thus, prayed that this petition be allowed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Rajesh Beniwal verifies that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to order dated 02.06.2017. Her custodial interrogation is not required.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioner is likely to abscond or that she is likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances noted above but without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Consequently, order dated 02.06.2017 is made absolute.
