Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners (allegedly) are being harassed on account of the fact that son of petitioners no.1 and 2 and nephew of petitioner no.3, is stated to be involved in a crime, in respect of which FIR no.26 dated 14.03.2017 for the alleged commission of offence punishable under Section 302 IPC, has been registered by the police of Police Station Mansa Devi, Panchkula.

He submits that in this regard they have made a representation to the Commissioner of Police, Panchkula on 22.05.2017 and the petitioners, at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the said officer, i.e. respondent no.2 herein, to take action as per law.

Consequently, without making any comment on the merits of the contentions made in this petition, or the representation made to the Commissioner of Police, Panchkula, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the said officer (respondent no.2), to look into the grievance of the petitioners and ensure that any action taken by the police is absolutely

within the 4 corners of law.
