Pursuant to the order dated 31.01.2017, learned State counsel has produced in Court today a letter written by the Additional General Manager (Administration-III), Hafed, Panchkula, dated 06.02.2017, addressed to Sub Inspector Subhash Chand of the CIA, Yamunanagar, stating therein that no letters dated 30.05.2015, 19.07.2015 and 31.08.2015 written by Amrik Singh, Food Inspector (S), have been received.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the police official who is present in Court today to assist him, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and presently his custodial interrogation is not required, as no incriminating evidence has been found against him so far by the investigating agency, though investigation is still going on.

The petition is, therefore, disposed of with a direction that upon condition of the petitioner continuing to join investigation, he would be

admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Illaqua
Magistrate.
