Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Reply filed on behalf of the respondent-State reveals that there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner. In fact, the police has conducted an inquiry, wherein it has been found that the petitioner and his son Amandeep Singh were tenants in the shop bearing No.77-B situated at Gurudwara Baba Phoola Singh, Amritsar. They had vacated the said shop on 15.04.2014 at their own. After vacating the shop, the petitioner and his son had never come to open the same. No such evidence has come on record that the petitioner and his son Amandeep Singh had vacated the said shop after

entering into any agreement with the landlord. However, the present petition seeking protection of life and liberty has been filed after a gap of 14 months of vacating the shop.

In view of the above, this Court finds that there is no merit in the present petition as the very object of filing the same is misconceived. The present petition is, consequently, dismissed.
