Petitioner-Shiv Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.108 dated 11.04.2017, registered at Police Station Chandhat, Palwal, under Sections 407, 411 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, on 08.04.2007, bags of sugar weighing 320 quintals, amounting to Rs.11,97,440/- were sent in a truck bearing registration No.RJ-21GA-4801 after loading. However, when the bags of sugar were not delivered at the destination in the morning of 09.04.2017, the driver was inquired on mobile phone, who stated that he got stuck in the traffic. However, the complainant later on came to know that the truck was stationed at Chaudhary Hotel. As per the prosecution version, co-accused Gaurav Goel has suffered a

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disclosure statement that 359 bags of sugar were purchased by him from Shiv Singh (petitioner), Raju and Jaspal @ Jassu.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
