Through the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for transfer of the investigation of the case to some independent agency.

Learned State counsel contends that on the representation of the petitioner, a Special Investigation Team (SIT) has been constituted under the officer of the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police. According to the F.S.L. report, which has now been received, the deceased died on account of drowning. The permission has also been obtained from the Illaqa Magistrate for lie detection test sought to be conducted on 12/13.03.2018 of five accused out of the total eight persons arrested in this case.

Considering the above factual aspect of the case, it can safely be presumed that the police is acting bonafidely and there is no necessity to transfer the investigation. Hence, this petition is dismissed.
