The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.599 dated 24.09.2014 registered for offences punishable under Sections 148, 323, 325, 395, 397 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") at Police Station City Yamunanagar, District Yamunanagar.

Heard.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the court, Mr. Apoorv Garg, DAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court accepts notice and submits that intimation by Registry informing of fixation of the petition has already been received and record of the case is available with him.

After being declared proclaimed offender on 07.08.2015, the petitioner was arrested on 21.03.2017 and is in custody since then.

Learned State counsel submits that challan has been presented against the petitioner and charges have also been framed against him.

In view of above but without expressing any opinion on merits

of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Baljinder Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
