Petitioner-Binder Kumar has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No19 dated 25.02.2017, registered at Police Station Chabbewal, District Hoshiarpur, under Sections 323, 324 and 34 IPC and Section 326 IPC added later on.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

Complainant has also appeared through his counsel.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner has been

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named in the FIR. He has been stated to be armed with *datar* and caused grievous injury on the little finger of complainant i.e. non-vital part of body.

Learned counsel for the parties state that parties have effected compromise.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 02.06.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 02.06.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
