Petitioner is seeking direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to register a case against respondent No.4 under the relevant sections of the Indian Penal Code, as he has been harassing her by demanding more dowry.

Marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with Balwinder Singh-respondent No.4 on 31.03.2007. Said Balwinder Singh was earlier married to one Sangeeta Devi, who had expired on 21.07.2007 and he had three children from his first marriage. Out of them two daughters are already married and one son is staying with the petitioner. As per petitioner, Balwinder Singh-respondent No.4 is harassing her on account of illicit relations with another girl. With regard to her grievance, the petitioner made a complaint/representation dated 03.04.2017 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali-respondent No.2, but no action has been taken thereon till date.

This petition is disposed of by giving direction to the Senior

Superintendent of Police, Mohali-respondent No.2 to look into the complaint/representation dated 03.04.2017 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate action in accordance with law.
